



Six students passed the October America's Boating Course. The recent Boat Handling course had seven students. The final quiz results are pending. We had no takers for the Advanced Powerboat Handling or Anchoring seminars.



December has several seminars: How to use Charts and GPS – 14 & 16 Dec, and Operations Training (important for new officers as well as new members) or What is the Whole Organization from National Down to Squadron –FREE on 04 December.

Scheduled to start in December are several courses. America's Boating Course on boat safety starts on 1 December. Instructor Development starts on 1 December. We need more certified instructors. This five session FREE course prepares you to present topics from America's Boating Course as well as other boating topics. We also started Offshore Navigation, formerly Junior Navigation, on 11 November but you can still join by contacting instructor P/C Tippy Cavanagh SN.

January has the start of one seminar and four courses. The courses are America's Boating Course, Marine Navigation (Piloting), Advanced Marine Navigation (Advanced Piloting) and Weather. Seminars are Advanced Powerboat Handling. A complete list of the education schedule through April 2022 with dates and costs is on the web site and later in this issue. 


